

Weather Appropriate Clothing

Finally, we have started to see more sunshine which the children and staff have been enjoying. Can we ask all parents/carers to please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing to allow them to access the outdoors. To help your child participate in activities can all parents/carers please provide the nursery with sun hats, wet weather gear for your child including a waterproof jacket or all-in-one and wellies. If you would like advice on this, please speak to a member of staff. Please clearly label all items of clothing.

Can we ask all parents/carers to please apply sun cream to your child in the morning or before the start of the nursery session. We ask for this to ensure the children have complete coverage and to allow the cream to activate before being exposed to the UV rays. The nursery staff will continue to apply sun cream throughout the nursery day. If your child has sensitive skin and is only able to use a particular sun cream, please provide this to the nursery with it clearly labelled with your child name. We will provide sun cream for those children who do not have any skin allergies.
