Clothing/Toys

Except for comforters used for sleeping can we please ask for all toys from home to remain at home and not to be brought into nursery. Any items brought in must be taken home by the parents before the child is left in our care. Parents will be asked by a staff member to take the items home.

Winter Clothing

Please ensure your child arrives at nursery with weather appropriate clothing that is clearly labelled. Please provide spare clothes for your child or if your child is sent home in nursery clothes can you please return these as quickly as possible.

Nursery Security

Please remember to pull the front door closed behind you when entering and exiting the nursery building to maintain the safety and security of the building.
