



Parent Consultations

The uptake this year for parent consultations has been very low. We also had several parents not showing up for booked appointments which is really disappointing especially as the staff already work exceptionally long days and organised to stay back or come in on their day off to have these meetings. The meetings allow parents and staff to sit and have time to discuss your child's development and progress without feeling rushed at drop off and pick up.

Water Bottles

Please take home all water bottles at the end of the day and return to us on your child's next session filled. We will continue to replenish the water during the day. Please ensure your child's cup is clearly labelled.

Clothing/Toys

We are still coming across children's clothing in all playrooms not being clearly labelled. Can we please ask again that all clothing is clearly labelled.

Except for comforters used for sleeping can we please ask for all toys from home to remain at home and not to be brought into nursery. Any items brought in must be taken home by the parents before the child is left in our care. Parents will be asked by a staff member to take the items home.

Summer

Please ensure your child arrives at nursery wearing sun cream. This is part of our sun protection procedure. All children should arrive at nursery with sun cream on to allow them direct access to all nursery areas. We will ensure sun cream is applied during the nursery day however it is the parent's responsibility to put sun cream on before the nursery session starts. All children should have a clearly labelled sun hat.

Please remember to pull the front door closed behind you when entering and exiting the nursery building to maintain the safety and security of the building.
